REMEMBER

Understand the material. Get meaning from the symbols. Explain ideas or concepts.

- Classify good food choices vs. bad.
- Translate words into an algebraic equation.

UNDERSTAND

Use the information you learned and now understand in new, concrete situations.

- Use different sentence openings.
- Compute/solve population ratios.
- Demonstrate proper warm-up exercises.
- Operate electric drills safely.
- Graph/sketch relative earnings.

APPLY

Draw connections among ideas. Break information down into its component parts.

- Diagram a sentence and distinguish its parts of speech.
- Contrast pinnate and palmate leaves.
- Compare long division algorithms.
- Differentiate between gov't systems.

ANALYZE

Make reasoned judgments based on clearly defined and defensible criteria. Justify a stand.

- Appraise the Peace Corps' effectiveness.
- Critique the production of the play.
- Select the best art. Defend your position.
- Weigh advantages and disadvantages.
- Judge which technique is the best to use.

EVALUATE

Put parts together in a creative way to produce a new thing that is both original and desirable.

- Formulate an algorithm.
- Author and illustrate a picture book.
- Develop an improved playground policy.
- Devise/design an experimental procedure.
- Compose a song to teach good posture.
