

TERM	DEFINITION	USE IN A SENTENCE	DRAW A PICTURE
BASIN	<p>The area of land drained by a given river and its branches</p> <p>an area of land surrounded by higher land</p>		
DELTA	<p>A D-shaped collection of silt and streams at the mouth of a river</p> <p>Flat, low-lying land built up from soil carried downstream by a river and deposited at its mouth</p>		
FLOW	<p>How a glacier moves downhill—it forms in mountains when snow accumulates over years until the ice is under so much pressure that it starts to flow (like water)</p>		
GLACIER	<p>A large, thick body of slowly-moving ice</p> <p>Carves out a <i>U-shaped</i> valley</p>		

LAKE	<p>A large body of fresh water</p> <p>A sizable inland body of water</p>		
MOUTH	<p>The place where a river or stream flows into a larger body of water</p>		
SOURCE	<p>The place where a river or stream begins</p>		
TRIBUTARY	<p>A smaller river pouring its water into a larger river</p> <p>A small river or stream that flows into a larger river or stream</p> <p>A branch of a river</p>		
RIVER	<p>A large, natural stream of water that runs through the land</p> <p>A river carves out a <i>V-shaped</i> valley</p>
