

Magazine (Periodical)

Directions

Author's last name, first name. "Title of article." *Title of magazine* day month year: pages used.

Print.

What the Directions Mean

Write the author's last name. Comma. Space. Write the author's first name (and any middle name or initials). Period. Space.

NOTE: If the author is unknown, or if there is more than one author, or if the author is a corporation, or if the book has an editor, use the same directions given for books!

In quotation marks write the title of the article. Put the period *inside* the end quote. Space.

Use italics to write the title of the magazine. Space.

Write the day and month (if given) or the month (if that's all that is given) the magazine was published (abbreviate all but May, June, and July). Space. Write the year the magazine was published. Colon. Space.

Write the numbers for the page numbers you used. (If the pages are consecutive, use a hyphen to show the first and last pages. If the pages are not consecutive, write just the first page and add a plus sign with no space.)Period. Space.

Unless you found the magazine online, write the word "Print." Period.

The entry is finished!
