Rewrite the question as the first part of the answer:</p> <p>Where did the story take place? <i>The story took place in ...</i></p> <p>Why did Anabelle dislike Jake at the beginning of the story? <i>Anabelle disliked Jake at the beginning of the story because</i></p>
<p>A</p>	<p>Answer the question. R and A are usually in in the same sentence.</p> <p><i>The story took place in London. Anabelle disliked Jake at the beginning of the story because he was mean to her brother.</i></p>
<p>C</p>	<p>Cite the source. Find supporting evidence in the text for your answer. Go to a second sentence! Make SURE you add your page citation.</p> <p><i>The first paragraph says the family moved to London (Adams, 1). Jake “sneered at Sammy” and said “you’re such a baby” (Lewis, 45).</i></p>
<p>E</p>	<p>Explain or give examples. Give further explanations or other examples or extend your answer to make it complete. Go to a third sentence or more.</p> <p><i>Jake also made fun of Sammy, calling him “a little dweeb” (Lewis, 53).</i></p>
